

WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL ART CLUB

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this organization shall be Washington Community High School Art Club.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to promote the Art Department of Washington Community High School and an interest in art throughout W.C.H.S. Art Club also sponsors the Da Vinci Award, purchases permanent art work for the school, and schedules a trip to the Art Institute of Chicago.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 - Membership shall be open to any student currently enrolled at Washington Community High School who is enrolled in art class and is willing to help support the club.

Section 2 – It is hoped that all members will attend all meetings and activities of Art Club. A member who is unable to attend a meeting must notify the president or club sponsor. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused absence. Two unexcused absences in a school year will be cause for dismissal from the organization. If dismissed, dues will not be refunded.

Section 3 – Members of Art Club are expected to follow the Rules and Regulations of the high school. Gross disobedience of school rules may lead to dismissal from Art Club.

ARTICLE IV- DUES

Section 1 - Dues will be \$10.00 per year. Dues are only subject to change by amending this constitution.

Section 2 – Membership dues shall include one Art Club T-Shirt.

ARTICLE V - OFFICERS

Section 1 - The President shall preside over all meetings and see that all projects are functioning correctly.

Section 2 - The Vice President shall assist the president and preside over the meetings if the president is absent.

Section 3 - The Secretary shall keep an accurate list of all members and their attendance records.

The secretary shall be responsible for the minutes of all business meetings and shall carry on all correspondence for the club. If the President and Vice President are absent, the secretary shall preside over the meeting.

Section 4 - The Treasurer shall collect all dues and keep a permanent and accurate record of the dues. The treasurer shall collect and make a record of all other special assessments or funds. The treasurer shall preside over the meeting if the above mentioned officers are not present.

Section 5 - The Student Council Representative shall represent the club at all Council meetings. The Rep. will be expected to make any reports on Council meetings that concern the Art Club.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

Section 1 - The club shall have a minimum of four (4) regularly scheduled business meetings per school year.

Section 2 - The President, with the consent of the sponsor, has the power to call any extra meetings that are necessary.

ARTICLE VII - COMMITTEES

The committees will consist of volunteers or members appointed by the President. The President shall oversee the work of all committees. A member may not refuse to work on a committee without just reason.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended at any regular business meeting at which two-thirds of the members are present. The club members must be notified of the amendment at least two weeks before the constitution is to be amended. Before the amendment is added to the constitution, it must be voted on and passed by a majority of the members present at the meeting.

ARTICLE IX - SPONSOR

The club sponsor shall assume the right to disqualify any student holding an office if the student abuses or misuses or does not fulfill the given duties.

1. The sponsor shall use the right to remove from office any student that abuses or does not fulfill the club delegated duties.
2. The sponsor shall appoint a new officer for the position upon a vacancy.
3. The sponsor will preside over all club meetings and be the authority in charge of social and fund raising activities.
