

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SELECTION OF THE “DA VINCI” ART DEPARTMENT AWARD

Factual Qualifications

1. The student must be a senior.
2. The student must have completed or be completing a minimum of two years of art.
3. The student must express interest in continuing studies in art beyond high school.
4. Grades must be a “B” average or above in art.
5. Grades must be a “C” average or above in other scholastic work and no failing grades during the senior year.
6. The student **must** be a member of the art club.

Personal Characteristic Qualifications

1. Application and usage of the artistic talent.
2. Cooperativeness in all phases of the school functions for the art department.
3. Interest in promoting the appreciation of art around school and the community.

Voting Procedure and Award Significance

Candidates for the award will set up an exhibition of their art work. All Art Club members in good standing will view the exhibit, then vote for the candidate whose work best exemplifies talent, creativity and craftsmanship.

Type of Award

A wall plaque of wood with metal name plate inscriptions will list the yearly award winner. The plaque will be hung in the hall near the art room. A check for \$50.00 will be awarded to the recipient.

Award Significance

This award is not only a monetary award, but one that signifies outstanding talent, ability, achievement, scholastic merit and future promise in Fine Arts.
